## The successful applicant must meet the following criteria:

The \$750 Scholarship Award is chosen by the RYSA Scholarship Committee.

A candidate who for three or more years has played with a team affiliated with Richmond Youth Soccer Association (RYSA) and who is currently participating in some capacity in youth soccer.

A letter of reference indicating the involvement he has had during the three years, must accompany the application, (Metro/Select League, Premier or Club Team)

A candidate must have proficiency in soccer as indicated by his play or shown worthwhile contribution to the sport, refereeing or coaching. He must also demonstrate good citizenship, good character and leadership qualities while being involved in youth soccer.

He must be a resident of the City of Richmond and proceeding from Grade 12 with a minimum of C+ average or better to any University or other post secondary institution approved by the Committee. A copy of the most recent school transcript indicating current grades and courses being attended must accompany the application.

The RYSA scholarship award will be presented to the successful applicant upon receipt of proof that he will be attending a University or post-secondary institution.
